Readers who make inferences use the clues in the text along with their own experiences to help them figure out what is not directly said, making the text personal and memorable. Helping students make texts memorable will help them gain more personal pleasure from reading, read the text more critically, and remember and apply what they have read. Inferences | Reading Comprehension Exercise - TeacherVision Making inferences requires students to combine what they are reading with what they already know, to reach into their own personal knowledge and apply it to what they are reading.
