Libel is actionable per se, so there is no need to prove actual damage suffered due to the defamatory statement. The Law On Defamation Relating To Social Media ... A person under investigation can sue for libel if the media reports their name or other piece of identifying information, if the investigation does not lead to a prosecution. The media

can only safely publish the name of someone under investigation if a spokesperson for a government agency specifically releases it.
