Glands Salivary gland tumors are growths of abnormal cells (tumors) that begin in the salivary glands.

Salivary glands make saliva, which aids in digestion, keeps your mouth moist and supports healthy teeth.

Care Adenoid cystic carcinoma is the most common malignant tumor of minor salivary glands (and of the trachea). It is a slowly growing malignant transformation of a much more common benign cylindroma.

The parotid glands are one set of three pairs of major salivary glands. Each set of glands has its own tube (duct) leading from the gland to the mouth. Parotid tumors are

abnormal growths of cells (tumors) that form in the parotid glands. The parotid glands are two salivary glands that sit just in front of the ears on each side of the

major salivary glands on each side of the face: The parotid glands, the largest salivary glands, are just in front of the ears. About 7 out of 10 salivary gland tumors start here. Most of these tumors are benign (not cancer), but the parotid glands still are where most malignant (cancerous) salivary gland tumors start. Surgery here is complicated by the fact that the facial nerve , which controls movement on the same side of the face, passes through the gland.
